Name:

The Name of Club will be: Students for Justice in Palestine

Article II

Purpose of the Club:

The club has been organized to: Build a community that is dedicated to sharing Palestinian sociopolitical history and increasing cultural awareness. We stand in solidarity of the Palestinian struggle for self-determination and support other movements that are seeking justice, equity, and freedom. We call for an immediate ceasefire and end to the occupation of Palestinian territories.

Article III

Authority:

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV

Membership:

Membership is open to all SBCC Students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

Article V

Meetings:

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC 217.

Article VI

Officers:

President - Preside over all meetings. Call special meetings.

Vice President - Supports presidents, takes over in his/her/their absence.

Secretary - Records minutes of club meetings.

Treasurer - Keeps financial record.

Elections:
Officers shall serve 1 term and will be elected each semester by popularity vote.
