- d. Treasurer: Keeps financial record, assists in any fundraising/donations.
- e. Club promoter: Promotes/advertises the club. Is in charge of all social media accounts, and posts with President approval.

All officers will strive to go above and beyond what is expected of them, and be willing to work to the best of their ability. As representatives of the club, they will maintain integrity and have respect for all club members and campus personnel.

Officer requirements

To be an officer, one must: a. Have/maintain a minimum GPA of 3.5 (unless vetoed by the adviser) b. Be of good moral standing c. Be recommended by the adviser or a STEM faculty member d. Have a majority vote by present members.

Amendments

The Constitution shall be amended upon approval by the adviser, upon approval of 75% of active club members, or upon approval of 95% of total club members.
