

## BADMINTON CLUB

The name of the club is Santa Barbara City College Badminton Club.

The purposes of this club are to improve skills in Badminton and also to promote Badminton as a competitive sport activities.

Membership is open to all faculty, staff and students of Santa Barbara City College and we also invite non SBCC's to join the club.

Club officers are to be elected each year and shall include a President and a treasurer. Officers should be Santa Barbara City College's students or staff. Other officers may be appointed by the above officers (if needed).

Club officers and members shall meet at least once a week. The Club shall conduct activities on an average of once a week.

This constitution shall be amended upon the approval of two thirds of the Badminton Club's members.

The S.B.C.C. Badminton club join together here in this club for three purposes:

- ◆ To improve our skills and techniques of playing badminton.
- ◆ To promote Badminton as a competitive sport activities.

Membership is open to all Santa Barbara City College students, faculty and staff. Members may take classes for credit but this is not a requirement for membership.

Active membership shall be maintained by regular participation in weekly meetings and activities. Roll call may be taken if needed.

There will be no dues payable this semester.

Officer will be elected once a year (or a semester if needed) and at least to consist of a President and a Treasurer. Other officers may be elected by any of the above officers if needed. Officer elected should be Santa Barbara City College's students or staffs.

### Duties of Officers

- ◆ The President shall preside over all meetings and shall represent the organization on the student legislative senate.
- ◆ The Treasurer shall maintain all financial records and might represent and officiate for the president in his absence.

### Duties of executive boards

- ◆ The executive board will meet at least once a week.

### Elections

- ◆ Elections will be held once a semester and will be taken at the beginning or at the end of semester.
- ◆ Elections shall be open to general membership.

### Meeting and Other Activities

- ◆ Special meetings will be called if needed or when a problem arise.
- ◆ Practices that will be taken every week shall be maintained in strict level as competitive games and as preparation of possible exhibition or competition.
- ◆ There will be one competition each semester to set ranks of players.

### Revisions

- ◆ The constitution may be amended by two thirds votes by general members in any meetings.
- ◆ Additional revisions will be added if needed.
