

## BLACK STUDENT UNION

This organization shall hereafter be referred to as the Black Student Union of SBCC.

The Black Student Union will serve the currently enrolled students of SBCC who are interested in any and all aspects and periods of Black History.

All members will have equal voting rights – 1 member's 1 vote. A simple majority is required to carry a measure. No quorum is required to initiate the vote.

Membership is open to any student who is an active participant.

Officers will be elected each semester:

President - Directs the meetings and club projects – shall act as a figurehead and represent club in full capacity.

Vice-President – shall act as liaison between the club advisor, officers and members of the club.

Treasurer – shall handle all financial matters and manage the club's assets.

Club meetings will be held bimonthly. Special meetings can be held by officers, and are subject to vote.

Amendments to the Black Student Union constitution shall be made by the members by a vote of a simple majority and subject to the quorum requirements.
