Article I: Name

- The Name of the Club will be Global Perspective Forums Club

Article II: Purpose of the Club

The club has been organized to foster a community of Santa Barbara City College students interested in discussing, understanding, and analyzing global issues from a diverse array of perspectives. Specifically, the club aims to:

- 1. Increase awareness and understanding of international affairs, global security threats, and their impacts across different regions and cultures
- 2. Facilitate open dialogue and exchange of ideas
- 3. Organize guest lectures, panel discussions, and interactive sessions with experts in fields such as international relations, history, economics, and environmental science
- 4. Engage members in critical thinking and collaborative problem-solving focused on global issues
- 5. Build a network of students, faculty, and professionals with an interest in international issues, fostering mentorship, internships, and career development
- 6. Organize events, workshops, and campaigns within the SBCC community to highlight the importance of global citizenship and the role of informed individuals in shaping a better world

Article III: Authority

- The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV: Membership (Mandatory)

- Membership is open to all SBCC Students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

Article V: Meetings

- Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC 217.

Article VI: Officers (example, recommended)

- **President:** Presides over all meetings, chooses the subjects of the meetings with the Vice President and The Global Security Adviser, and calls special meetings.
- Vice President: Supports the president, takes over in his/her/their absence.
- Secretary: Records minutes of club meetings and is head interviewer of guests.
- **Global Security Advisor:** Looks at the 10 different security threats the world faces, emphasizing the worldwide scope of the security issues being addressed.
- Treasurer: In charge of maintaining all financial matters.

Article VII: Elections

- Officers shall serve 1 term and will be elected each semester.

Article VIII: Amendments

- The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 60% or higher of the Club members.
