(Name of the Club)

Article II

(Purpose of Club)

Secretary – Records minutes of club meetings.

Treasurer – Keeps financial record.

Project Manager - Helps with programming problems.

Promoter - Advertises the club.

Article VII

(Elections)

Officers shall serve 1 term(s) and will be elected each semester.

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 55% of the Club members
